Coordinator for Bosnia

Starting Date: 01th July (or earlier)

In Bosnia, we have a branch of the German NGO to provide medical aid along the Balkan route. We are very mobile here and mostly work in squats and other structures. As we had to restructure the project on the ground, we are still in the process of realigning it, so as a coordinator you can actively help shape and build up the project. In addition to you, the team on site will consist of two other medical volunteers and we have a local administrative manager who will support you.

Location: Bihac, Bosnia

Type of contract: Honorary contract, 800€ per month, duration minimum 3 months (tourist visa) but we'd prefer longer and will support with other visas.

Tasks:

- structural expansion and development of the project
- Contact person for MVI in Bosnia
- Regular reporting to the head office/executive board
- Very close cooperation with the project management/executive board and local CEO
- Budget monitoring and management
- Building new partnerships and collaboration on the ground
- Preparing advocacy reports and constantly evaluating the situation on the ground
- Identifying opportunities to improve the project on the ground
- Developing new ways to reach people in need more effectively

Requirements:

90 days free entry in Bosnia must be guaranteed. This means that you have not been in Bosnia in the last 180 days.

- Medical background is required
- Experience in the field of humanitarian aid and/or health care
- Knowledge of project work
