

## Volunteers for Team Care & Support Wanted

Medical Solidarity International e.V. / Medical Volunteers International e.V. (MSI/MVI) supports people on the move at the European external borders with medical and psychosocial aid – especially where state structures fail. With the project WeCare, MSI/MVI has also been offering digital, low-threshold psychosocial counseling for refugees in Germany since 2024 – anonymous, free of charge, and in multiple languages.

We are currently strengthening our structures and building up Team Care & Support. For this, we are looking for volunteers with a psychological or psychosocial background who want to accompany and support our volunteers – both in field projects and in digital counseling. They are confronted with challenging situations on a daily basis, and our goal is to provide them with reliable backing. Team Care & Support sees itself as a volunteer psychosocial backoffice: we listen, provide stability, and help process strain and emotional stress.

Your tasks:

- Support during and after project deployments through brief check-ins, reflection, and emotional relief.
- Accompany advisors and interpreters in challenging counseling situations.
- Provide practical self-care tips and tools.
- Refer team members to external specialists when needed.
- Offer supervision or similar formats when appropriate.
- Contribute to Mental Health Sessions (long-term goal).

We offer:

- The opportunity to directly strengthen the psychosocial stability of our deployment and counseling teams and help shape this new team from the ground up.
- Voluntary work with flexible time commitment (approx. 5–15h/month).
- Collaboration in an engaged, international team.

Requirements:

- Psychological or psychosocial expertise (e.g., psychologist, therapist, or in training).
- Experience in handling stressful situations is a plus.
- Empathy, resilience, and strong communication skills.
- Interest in voluntary, flexible engagement (approx. 5–15h/month).
