Coordinator for Kos

Starting Date: 07. January (until April 2025)

In Greece we have founded our association Medical Solidarity International to create a suitable working framework. We have been able to establish our own consulting room in Kos, not far from the CCAC arrival center, where we can offer basic medical care, as this is only available or insufficiently available in the camp and is not accessible to people living outside the camp anyway. We work in a small team and also offer a weekly consultation at partner NGOs in Kos Town. We have also established a Country Coordination in Athens, which constantly supports and advises the coordination in Kos. As a coordinator in Kos, you will lead the team on the ground, do the weekly planning, meet with cooperation partners and be the contact person on place. A medical background is a great advantage but not absolutely necessary.

Type of contract: Honorary contract, 800€ per month, duration 4 months (Jan-April)

Tasks:

- Contact person for MVI in KOS
- Regular reporting to the head office/executive board and the Greek country coordination
- Very close cooperation with the project management/executive board
- Budget monitoring and management
- Team lead on the ground
- Building new partnerships and collaboration on the ground
- Constantly evaluating the situation on the ground
- Reporting for Social Media/Newsletter

Requirements:

- Medical background is a huge benefit
- Experience in the field of humanitarian aid and/or health care
- Knowledge of project work
- Human rights activism
- Strong communication and teamwork skills
